Ben was born on October 25, 1977 in Fort Worth, Texas to Nicholas and Robin DeFabbio. At the age of 18 Ben joined the United States Navy and proudly served his country, taking great pride in following in his father's footsteps. Ben worked as a nurse where he found fulfillment in helping and caring for others. Ben was no stranger to pain and suffering. He shared that he never felt like he fit in or belonged, from childhood on. 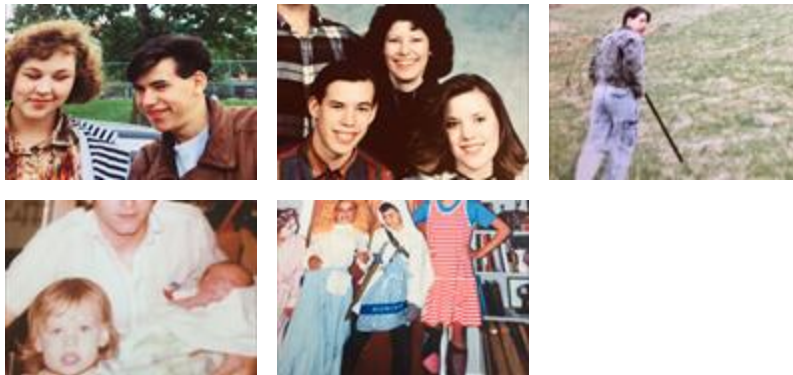

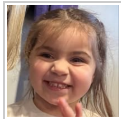

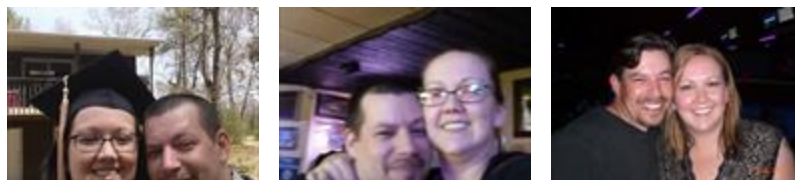
