Chester "Chet" William Wilson, age 62, of Boaz, found peace at last on February 28, 2019 at the Gundersen Boscobel Hospital following a difficult battle with cancer. He was born on February 25, 1957 in Richland Center, the son of Cliffton William Wilson and Dorothy Dean (Tiser) Wilson. Chet met his wife, Julie Rose (née Hallen) Wilson, while working for American TV in Madison in the late 1980s. They married on March 30, 1990 and made their home in both Evansville and Madison before moving to the Richland Center area in 2001.
