Dale Wilmar Balsley, 83, passed away peacefully Saturday, May 8, 2021, at his home in Richland Center, Wisconsin. He was born March 31, 1938, in Marshall Township on English Ridge at his grandmother's home, the son of Donald Eugene and Doris Arlene (Doudna) Balsley. Dale graduated from Richland Center High School and joined the United States Marines for 8 years. He married Patricia Ann Stafford on June 27, 1964, at St. Philips Catholic Church Rolling Ground.
