David “Dave” K. Manning, age 85, of Ithaca passed away on Sunday, March 22, 2020, at Gundersen Lutheran Medical Center in La Crosse after a long battle with lung & kidney disease. He was born on September 15, 1934, the son of Ruby Johnson Shetler. In 1950 as an Eagle Scout he attended the Boy Scout Jamboree in Washington D.C. He served his country in the United States Army from 1954- 1956. He married Alma Hissey on August 19, 1955. Dave was an avid farmer in Richland County near Ithaca for over 50 years. He was on many boards such as at Ithaca School Board, D.H.I.A., Holstein Association, PCA, South West Tech., Ash Creek Church and Willow Valley Church Boards. For many years he was a 4H Leader and softball coach. Dave was honored as Richland County OYF. He truly enjoyed farming, playing softball, and bowling and always enjoyed time with his bowling friends especially the fun trips to State Bowling. He loved talking to everyone. He loved watching his sons compete in football, basketball, and wrestling. Most recently he enjoyed his grandchildren and great grandchildren participate in these same sports. He taught his sons, grandkids, and now great grandkids that hard work was good for them and had a great love for all his family.
