Donald Edward Warner Sr., age 87, of Richland Center, WI passed away peacefully Thursday, March 26, 2020, at Agrace Hospice Center in Fitchburg, WI. He was born on February 15, 1933, in Winfield, Missouri, the son of Charles & Pearl (Billiel) Warner. The family relocated from Missouri and settled in Gotham, Wisconsin. There he grew up, and at age 20 he enlisted in the United States Army. He was stationed at Fort Leonard Wood and Fort Bliss and served in active duty during 1953-1956 in the Korean Conflict. In 1953 he married Loretta (Fitzpatrick) Warner and together they raised 8 children; 5 girls and 3 boys.

After active duty he worked in sawmills, Badger Ordinance, and was a security guard at the House on the Rock. Donald enjoyed fishing with his brothers Charlie, Clyde, and Family on the Wisconsin River, going to casinos, and watching Brian (his youngest son) race at the Dells Raceway Park in Wisconsin Dells. He also enjoyed watching Nascar and listening to country music.

The last 7 years of life he spent his time with a special friend (girlfriend) Shirley Kilby.

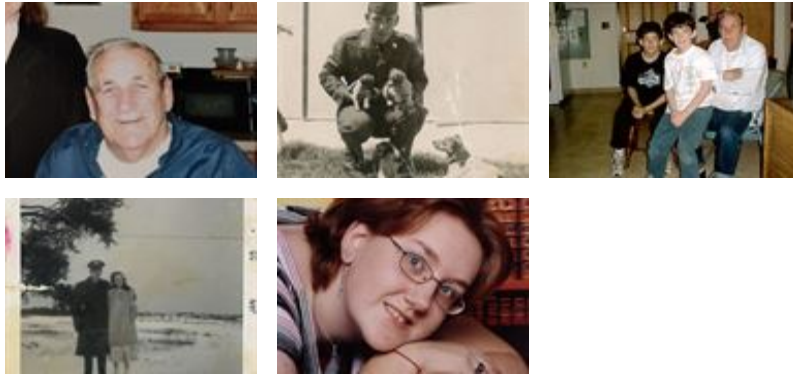
