LONE ROCK - Edward "Ed" James McCaskey, truck driver, logger, builder, died Saturday, July 9, 2016. He passed away quietly at home surrounded by family after a long struggle with throat and lung cancer. He was 71.

McCaskey was born to Donald and Lucy (Oler) McCaskey on December, 4, 1944. He grew up on the family dairy farm just west of Richland Center, with his younger siblings Donald, Diane, and Michael.

Ed spent much of his time driving semi, working in his shop, stirring the pot, logging, vacationing (i.e. working in a location not in Lone Rock), stirring the pot, farming, and don't forget...stirring the pot.

Survivors include his 2 children, Miranda (John) Stamps of Sallisaw, OK, Matthew McCaskey (Mary Shenk) of Boonville, MO; a sister, Diane (Pat) Clements of Richland Center; a brother, Mike (Sonja) McCaskey of Richland Center; nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents; wife, Jean Binder McCaskey; a son, Mark E. McCaskey and a brother, Donald E. McCaskey.
