Emanuel Lunk, age 89, passed away peacefully on Friday, June 7, 2024, at his home in Richland Center. He was born on March 21, 1935, in Marienwerder, West Prussia, Germany, the son of Max Johan Lunk and Helene Hellwig. Emanuel was the first in his family to emigrate to the United States, with his parents and siblings joining him later in 1953. A self-trained musician and talented guitarist, Emanuel also played the autoharp and accordion. He was known for his self-sufficiency and strong belief in sustainable, independent living, a testament to his resourcefulness and independent spirit.
