Gary Dobbs, age 67, passed away Friday, May 31, 2019, at his home in Sextonville surrounded by his family. He was born July 1, 1951 in Richland Center, WI, the son of Robert Hallie & Juanita Lydia (Coleman) Dobbs. After graduating from Ithaca in 1969 he served his country joining the United States Army for 4 years. Gary was very family-oriented and an awesome grandpa, father, brother and uncle. He loved following his grandchildren, nieces, and nephews at their sporting events. Gary was a people magnet and had a loving spirit. 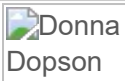
