



## "Gus" Augustine William Louis

August 3, 1931 - January 30, 2015

"Gus" Augustine W. Louis, age 83, of Ithaca died Friday, January 30, 2015, at St. Mary's Hospital in Madison, Wisconsin. On August 3, 1931 he was born in Marinette County, Wisconsin the son of Henry and Catherine (Honer) Louis. Gus married Arlene M. Gruber on April 25, 1950 at St. Patrick's, Loretta. Gus owned and operated the gas station in Ithaca for 20 years, worked at Town and Country Tire for several years, drove bus for Ithaca Schools for 9 years, and retired from Cardinal Glass after working for 7 years. Gus liked fishing, hunting, spending time with his many grandchildren, gardening, making homemade wine, sauerkraut and dill pickles.
