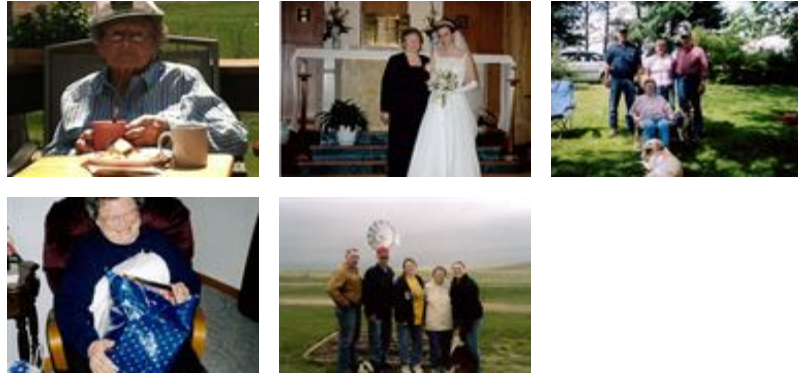

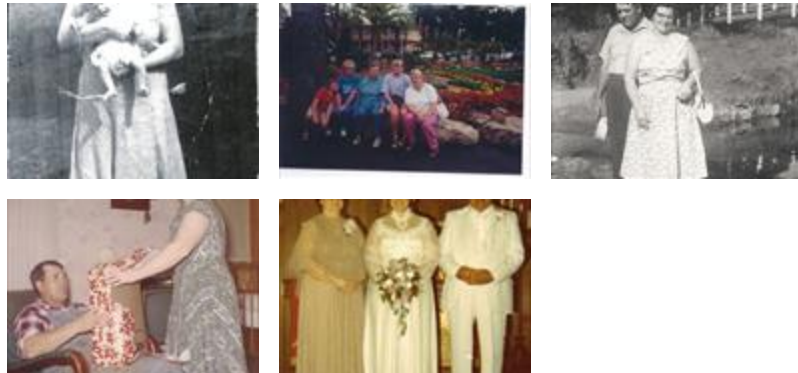

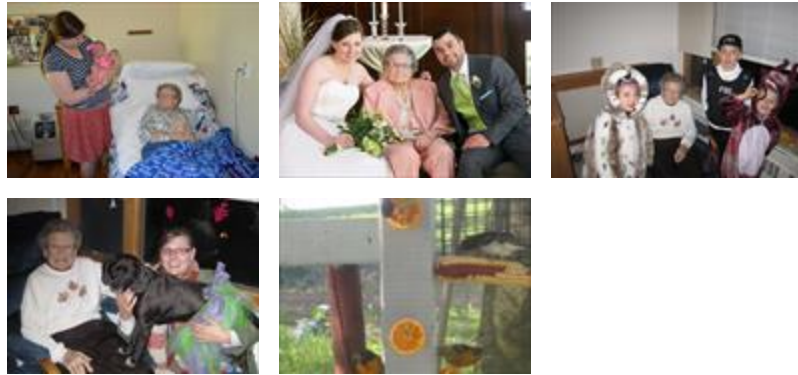

I hope this memory gives you some warmth as I know all the memories you will share with each other will help you through this time of loss.

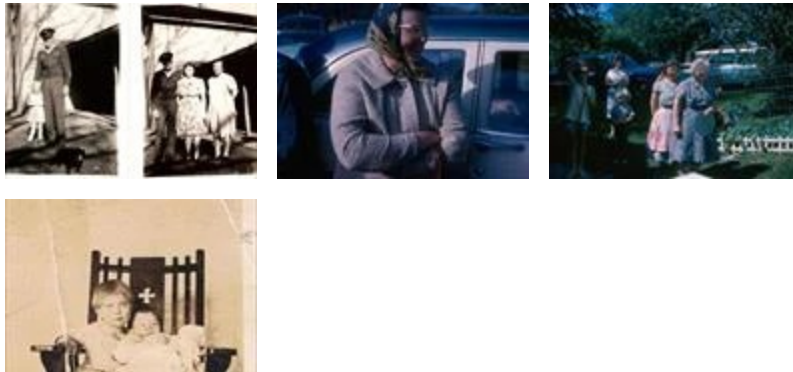

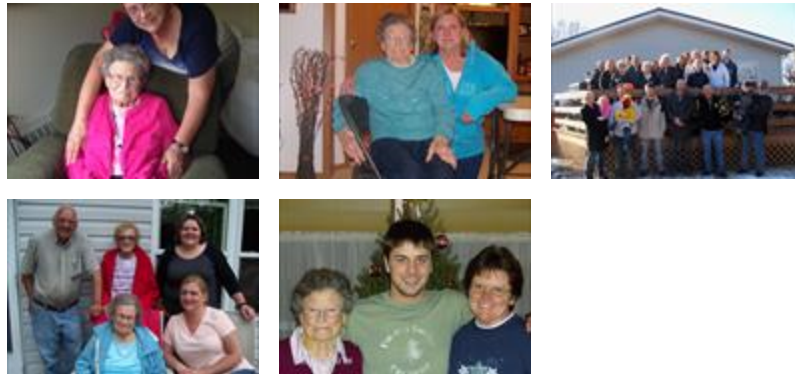
