Jane Ann Gainor, 57, of Boscobel, Wisconsin, passed away peacefully at her home on August 8, 2025, surrounded by her loving family and her cherished Persian cat, Gabbi.

Born May 24, 1968, in Richland Center, Jane was the daughter of Dale and Patricia Balsley. She graduated with a degree in nursing and went on to dedicate more than three decades of her life to caring for others as a registered nurse at the Richland Hospital, where she worked from 1988 until her retirement 2022. 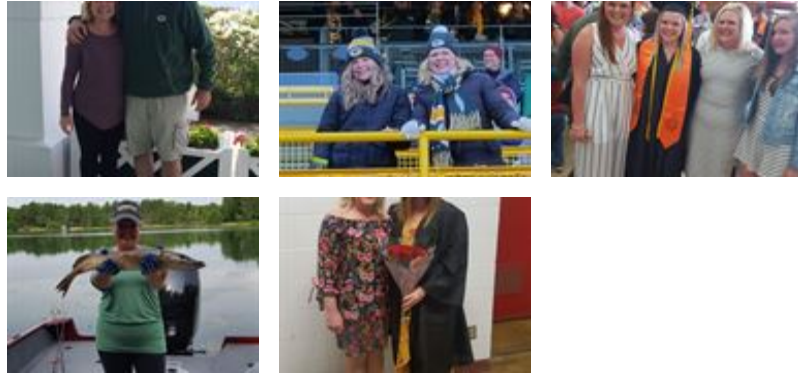
