February 14, 1919 - August 18, 2023

Jerry R. Durst, age 104, of Keyesville, WI, passed away peacefully Friday, August 18, 2023, at the Richland Hospital. He was born on February 14, 1919, the son of Adam and Laretta (Dederick) Durst. Jerry graduated from Ithaca High School in 1936. He married Florence Agnes Wankerl on Thanksgiving Day November 20, 1941, at St. Luke's Catholic Church in Plain. They were married for over 70 wonderful years and lived in the same farmhouse ever since.
