“ *Loosing a father is hard whatever the circumstances. Our father John lived a life marked with happy times but also challenging health conditions early and later in life. His spent most of his professional career dairy farming and, in his retirement, he enjoyed fishing in the Ozarks. He traveled to his beloved birthplace, Switzerland, whenever he could, where he enjoyed visiting with family and friends.*

Our father grew up with two older brothers and was tested very early in life by losing both his parents, Berthe and Joseph, and his brother, Roger.
