Joseph John Rut, age 78 was called to his heavenly home on Monday, May 11th, 2015. Joe was born on May 25, 1936 in Muscoda, the son of Joseph and Elsie (Steen) Rut. He married Ruth McDonough on August 8, 1964 in Muscoda.

Joseph graduated from Muscoda High School in 1954. He served in the U.S Army, in 1959 through 1962.
