Dad attended St. Mary's Grade School in Keyesville and Lone Rock High School. With brothers Francis and Erwin, he owned and operated Schmitz Bear Valley Cheese Factory and Chimney Rock Farm. A powerful young man, he was an excellent boxer, enjoyed playing softball, and was known to be able to carry four full milk cans at a time. We marveled that as a high school student, the principal trusted Dad enough to lend him his own car to drive a load of forensic students to Madison and back.
