Kay S. Wyman, age 80 of Richland Center died Wednesday, August 16, 2017, at Meriter Park Hospital in Madison, WI. She was born on May 1, 1937 in Mather, WI in Juneau County. On November 10, 1956 she married Larry D. Wyman at the First Congregational Church in Wisconsin Rapids and he preceded her in death on March 16, 2012.

Kay worked at the Richland Medical Center for over 40 years, most of them as Assistant Administrator. She saw its growth from the Pippin Clinic to the Richland Medical Center and then the move to join with the Richland Center Hospital. She was also a member of Partners, and worked in the Lobby Shop at the hospital.

Kay liked to quilt and read mysteries, but more than that, she loved to travel with Larry in their motor home. They enjoyed seeing the country and making new friends along the way. They were members of the Richland Ramblers and the Badger Chapter of the FMCA, both motor home camping groups. The highlight of their travels was a 3+ month trip to Alaska in 2001. There were endless stories; nothing else compared to that adventure. It was the trip of a lifetime, and the memories never faded.
