Keven P. Norman, age 92, of Richland Center died unexpectedly on Sunday, March 10, 2013 at the Richland Hospital. Keven was born March 18, 1920 in Richland Center, the son of Arthur & Bessie (Peckham) Norman. He married Elaine Hanson on July 28, 1948 in Wyoming Valley, near Spring Green, Wisconsin. Keven and Elaine settled on the Norman Family farm in Richland Center, where he was a dairy farmer for 15 years. Kev also worked as a union carpenter until his retirement.

He lived his life well, with pride and dignity. He leaves his family with wonderful memories and will be greatly missed.
