Lois “Jean” DeLaMater, 79, of Richland Center, passed away unexpectedly on September 2, 2025. Jean was born in Boscobel, on October 17, 1945, to Myron and Freeda (Hughbanks) Richardson and raised in Steuben. She married Carl on September 30, 1967. They had 2 children, Carla and Charles “Chucky”. Jean retired from Allen-Bradley in 2009, after working there for 38 years. 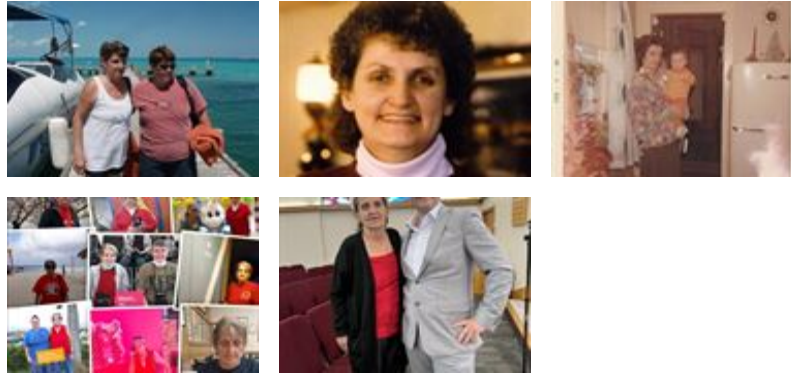
