Lynn Marree Jasper, 52, of Richland Center passed away peacefully with her family by her side on Wednesday, February 16, 2022, at home in Dayton Township. She was born in Jacksonville Beach, Florida, November 12, 1969, to LaVern and Betty Atkinson, where her father was stationed in the Navy. Lynn grew up around Boscobel and Wauzeka, left high school in 1987 and got her GED at SWTC, where she also got an accounting degree. She worked at Equity livestock from 1999-2009, then left to help her husband on their dairy farm. On April 11, 1997 she married Kevin Jasper. In 2011 they decided to buy the Lonesome Dove Tavern in Boaz. Lynn loved horse riding, traveling, spending time with family, (especially grandchildren) and friends. Loved country life and hosting cookouts and parties. Fought cancer 4 times (2012, 2020, 2021).

Survivors include her husband Kevin Jasper of Richland Center; a daughter, Jamie (Justin) Glasbrenner of Boscobel; a son, Lucas Elrod of Muscoda; 3 grandchildren, Gabby, Ava, JC; a sister, Tina (Mike) Stuckey of Fennimore; a brother, Jack (Leslie) Atkinson of Ohio; parents, LaVern and Betty Atkinson of Prairie du Chien; many nieces, nephews, and many friends.

A funeral service for Lynn will be held on Monday, February 28, 2022, at 11:00 AM at Clary Memorial Funeral Home in Richland Center with Ron Fruit officiating. 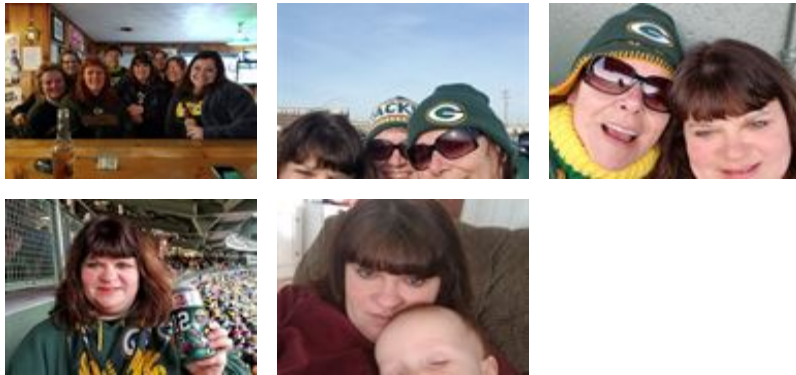

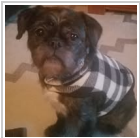
