



## Marguerite Jean Carver

March 24, 1925 - July 2, 2022

Marguerite J. Carver, 97, of Spring Green passed into the arms of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Saturday, July 2, 2022, at Greenway Manor in Spring Green. She was born the daughter of Leonard & Ercel (Klopfenstein) Sumney on March 24, 1925 in Allen County, Indiana. She loved Jesus, to the day she passed into His presence and now for eternity. She accepted Jesus as her Savior when she was a little girl and was active in the Evangelical Mennonite Church in Grabill, IN. She sang in a Women's Trio in college and played basketball. She graduated from Fort Wayne Gospel Temple in 1948 and was married to Albert Carver on July 31, 1948 in Grabill, Indiana. They moved to Arena, WI in 1948 and then to Spring Green, WI in 1952. She was active in church ministry as a choir director, Sunday School teacher and AWANA. She also hosted Good News Club at her home. She worked for the Home News/ Village Press/ Spring Printing until she was in her 80's. She enjoyed her flower and vegetable gardens and preserving her produce. Her hobbies were cooking, sewing and knitting. Marguerite was a caregiver for her husband for many years and a servant wherever she was.

Survivors include her five children, Rodney (Vicki) Carver, Randall (Arlene) Carver, Rae Lee (Lawrence) Riggs, Rene (William) Schneider, Ryan (Dawn) Carver; 13 grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren; 2 sisters, Marceil (-Zehr)-Kryder, Sharon (David) VonGunten; a sister-in-law, Carol Sumney; many nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Albert Carver; a brother, Roland Sumney; 2 brothers-in-law, Thomas Zehr and Dick Kryder.
