June 18, 1941 - December 15, 2022

Ronald Robert Post, 81, died a natural death on December 15, 2022, at home in Richwood Township. He was born on June 18, 1941, in Richland Center, WI, the son of Robert and Helen (Rosenau) Post. He grew up in Muscoda and attended Muscoda High School, starring in football until he went to the Army from 1959-1961, doing his duty primarily in Alaska. Upon return, after living in Madison for a while but returned to the Muscoda area and worked for Scot Industries for many years as a truck driver and then mechanic. He became recognizable on the road with a big bear he strapped into the passenger seat of his truck. He retired around 2000 and became a gentleman farmer on Goplin Hill Road.

He was involved in many local activities including the Fire Department and the Rescue Squad. He often was a fighter in the competitions between fire departments to get the barrel over the line on the 4th of July! He also won the log hauling competitions a few years. After he retired, he continued to exhibit his cooking skills helping local groups by cooking hogs and chickens for the Harvest Festival, Morel Mushroom Days, and other events.

He was an avid hunting and fishing aficionado and often went north or west with his buddies to do just that. He was also a first-class bowler, bowled with several leagues, and won personal and league trophies.

He married Rosalie Kovars in 1985; she predeceased him in 1991. He is survived by his three sisters, Judee of California, Janet of Milwaukee, and Dianne of Arizona and a brother Rick of Muscoda. He was predeceased by his parents and his younger brother Randy. He has requested no services and will be buried in the Tavera Cemetery in Richland Center. A celebration of life will be held in Muscoda in the spring.
