Sharrel “Sharry” A. Rucinski., age 77, died Wednesday, December 22, 2021, at her birth home, on the family farm surrounded by her loving family in rural Yuba. 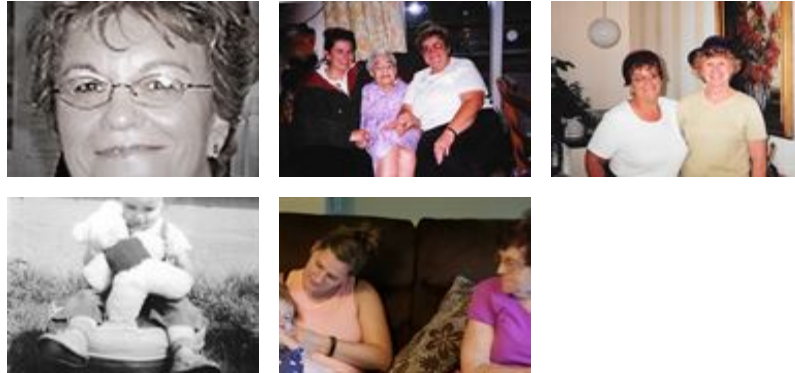
