Thomas "Tom" H. Grimm, age 85, of Muscoda, died Sunday, July 06, 2014 at the Richland Hospital. He was born on August 20, 1928 in Castle Rock Township the son of Clarence and Anna (Prochaska) Grimm. Tom married Mary Gies on October 2, 1954 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Richland Center. Tom was a dairy farmer who prided himself on his cows and his love for his family.
