Timothy E. Kearney, age 77, of Keyesville died Tuesday, February 18, 2014 at Our House Memory Care in Richland Center. He was born June 1, 1936 in Richland County the son of Edward and Mary (Pulvermacher) Kearney. Tim graduated from Ithaca High School in 1955. On June 18, 1960 he married Margaret Norwalk at St. Mary's Keyesville. As a young farmer he showed cattle statewide for the Brace Brothers. He loved snowmobiling and speed was one of his traits. Tim was a past member of the Ithaca Town Board, past Treasure/Secretary of the Richland County Wagon Train, past Horse Pulling President, and inducted into the Horse Pulling Hall of Fame 2001. Also, the Richland County Wagon Train was dedicated to Tim for 2013. Tim hauled livestock for 61 years. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church in Keyesville.
